<i>Course Description</i>	In this course, students are expected to acquire advanced oral communication skills. Students are required to construct informational, tourism-related texts. Furthermore, the course addresses translation-related issues, such as the processes and techniques of translating non-literary texts from French to Arabic, and vice versa. Throughout the course, students will practice identifying problems in vocabulary usage, expression and syntax, and finding solutions to them. The themes dealt with in this course are selected from various texts, books and magazines pertinent to tourism, culture and general information about Jordan.
<i>Course Aims</i>	The aims of the course are to provide students with a deeper understanding of the French language.
