Foreign Language – Italian 1 (141603101) (3 credit hours)

**Prerequisite:** none

## **Course description:**

The course is conceived for students without any knowledge of Italian language. It aims at the development of the skills for a **basic communicative interaction** by teaching **phonetics** and then communicative expressions and analyzing them to memorize **vocabulary**, to get familiar with **grammar** and also the **cultural attitudes** related to daily life and familiar situations. **Listening** activities (dialogues, interviews, and songs) and **conversation** practice are widely used during the lessons.

### **Course objectives:**

By the end of the course, students are expected to be able to:

- Write correctly any Italian word they hear;
- Ask for information, explanation and help during a lecture and in common daily situations;
- Dialogue asking and giving personal information using both formal and informal register;
- Introduce themselves orally ("monologue") and in written documents (CV, informal letters, emails);
- Understand a menu at the café or restaurant, order and pay;
- Talk about daily routine, free time and leisure.

#### **Course Learning Outcomes:**

- A) **Knowledge and understanding:** To understand general information and to communicate in standard speech on a range of everyday issues.
- B) Cognitive and intellectual skills (thinking and analysis): from globalizing exposure to analyzing and synthesizing of information
- C) Communication skills (personal and academic): To acquire the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing in Italian in a range of predictable situations.
- E) Practical and subject specific skills (transferable skills): To develop an insight into the nature of language, culture and society together with an intercultural competence.
