### **Introduction:**

Since the two parties are educational institutions and universities concerned with university education, teaching and scientific research and its development and serving the local, Arab and regional community, and the desire of the two parties for joint cooperation in order to exchange knowledge and experience between faculty members and students in both universities, the two parties agreed to cooperate in the following areas:

### **Article (1): Academic Cooperation**

- Exchanging faculty members and/or giving lectures according to specializations in the corresponding programs between the two parties.
- Encouraging faculty members to hold and organize local and international courses, conferences and joint workshops.



- Discussing the possibility of establishing joint master's and/or doctoral programs between the faculties of the two universities.
- Conducting scientific research between the two parties for faculty members, as well as joint supervision of master's and doctoral theses.
- Exchanging sabbatical leave for faculty members according to priorities determined by the two universities, and giving priority to faculty members from both sides if opportunities are available for that.
- Encouraging the two universities to grant scholarships to postgraduate students and to benefit from the post graduate programs available to both parties.
- Encouraging the two universities to grant scholarships to BA students and to benefit from the joint programs available to both parties.
- Giving priority to the supervision and discussion of postgraduate theses for faculty members from both universities.
- Giving priority to faculty members from both universities to teach as a "part-time" or "visiting professor" in both universities.

#### **Article (2): International Projects**

- Encouraging cooperation between the two universities in the field of international projects supported by external parties.

#### **Article (3): Extracurricular activities**

- Conducting joint local and international extracurricular activities for students between the two parties.
- Take advantage of the logistical services available to serve students.

#### **Article (4): Training Courses**

- Holding joint training courses and benefiting from the courses approved by both universities.

**Article (5): Scientific laboratories**

- Establishing joint scientific laboratories, especially in the disciplines of cloud computing, artificial intelligence, cyber security, software engineering and other engineering disciplines, benefiting from the experiences of the two parties in this field, and trying to provide the necessary support and fund for the establishment of these laboratories.

**Article (6): General Provisions**

- The term of this memorandum is four Gregorian years from the date of its signature and is automatically renewed, unless one of the two parties informs the other party of its desire not to renew it.
- This note consists of an introduction and six items, including this one, and they are all read as one unit.
