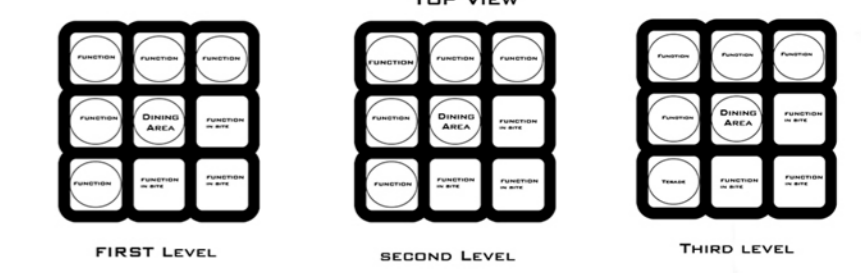


CONCEPT

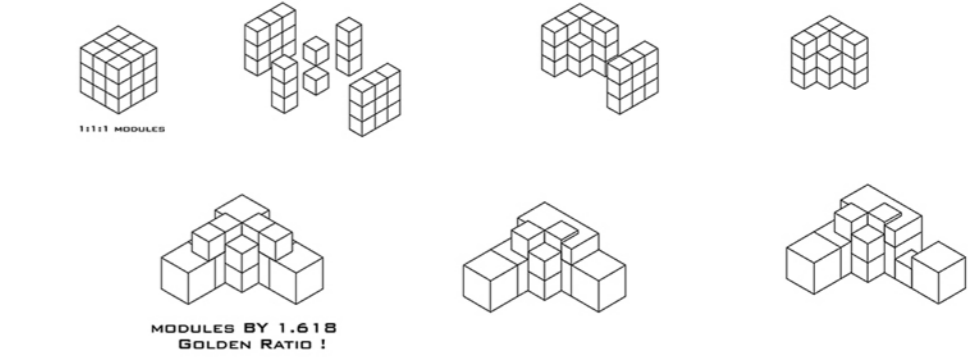
HOW AND WHY ?

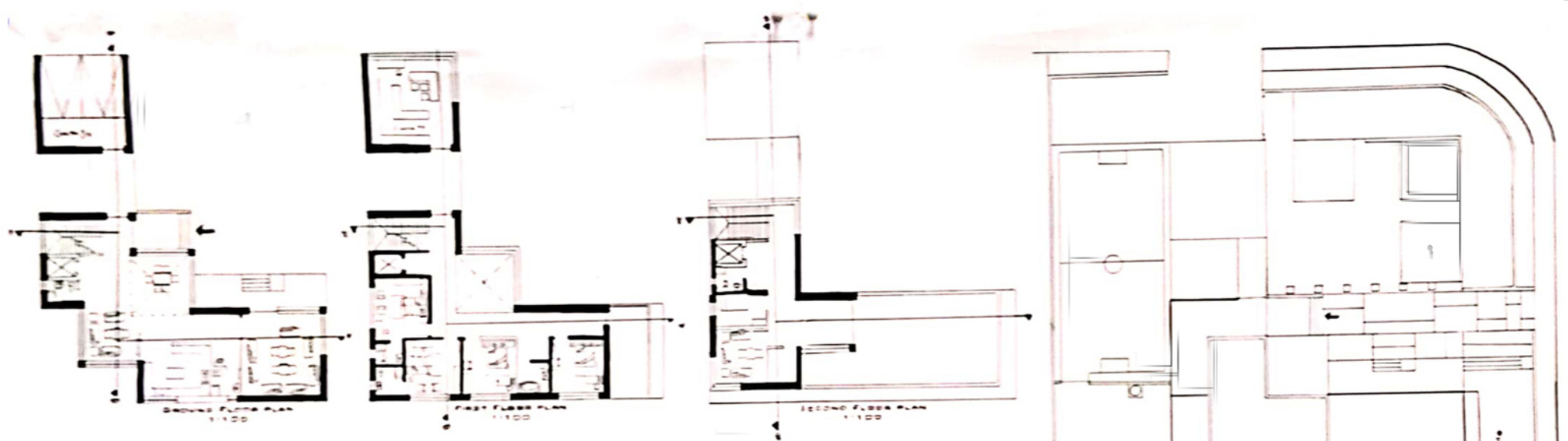

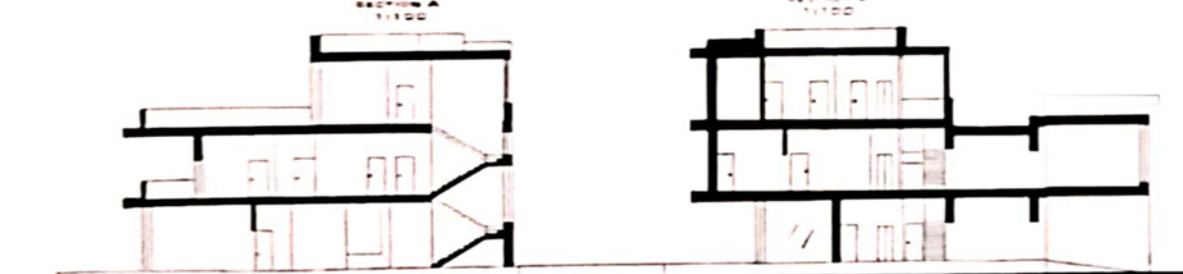
DEVELOPMENT OF THE COMPOSITE DEPENDING ON THE FUNCTIONS



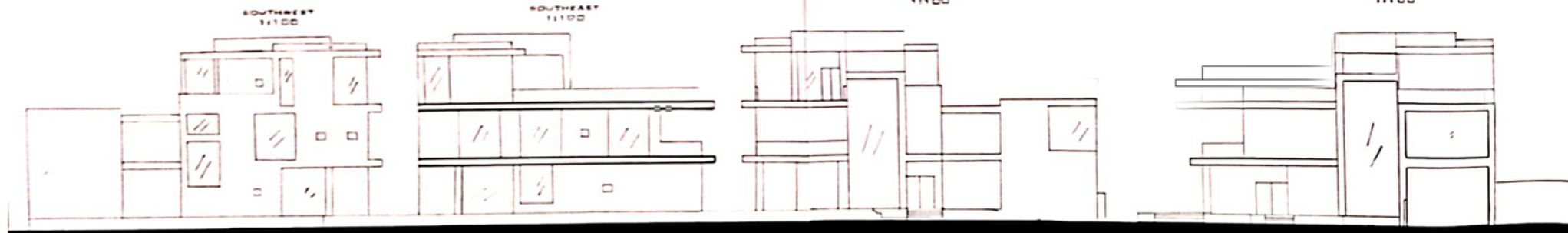
