* > Clinical Training at Faculty of Nursing

Clinical training facilities include nursing laboratories including a clinical simulation lab, which is designed to provide advanced learning experiences for students. This lab consists of realistic looking equipment and dummies, which allow learners to practice and develop medical and nursing care without any risk of patient harm.

Other clinical areas of clinical training include many acute and chronic healthcare facilities from various healthcare sectors in Jordan (hospitals and health centers of Ministry of Health and Royal Medical Services), and other national facilities such as schools (Ministry of Education and UNRWA-Jordan) and nursing homes.

The FON has a sufficient number of laboratory supervisors and clinical instructors who supervise the training of students in the laboratories and in the various practical training sites.
