The IT collage plan includes the short and long term needs for hiring new faculty members. Each IT department decides on its faculty hiring needs based on its teaching and research directions. The departments submit their hiring proposals to the dean together with the requirements for the open position(s). If the hiring request is approved by university administration, a job advertisement is posted on the university website and in major newspapers. Applicants for the opening position(s) have to submit an application form, copies of their degrees, and experiences to the human resources (HR) unit within certain period.

A short list of candidates is created based on their grades. Candidates with top grades are interviewed by the department head and committee. The department submits a short list of candidates to the dean. The dean arranges with the department head for an invitation of the candidates to give a presentation in the collage. The presentation is attended and evaluated by a number of faculty members from different IT departments.
