Applying for higher studies programs (Master and Diploma) for the first semester (2022/2023) electronically according to the following link:

The dean of the Faculty of the Graduate Studies at the Hashemite University announces the beginning of the Application process for the enrollment in the higher studies programs (Master and high diploma) for Jordanian and non-Jordanian students for the first semester of the academic year (2022-2023) starting from Thursday (18/8/2022) until Saturday evening (3/9/2022). Incomplete applications will not be studied, according to the rules of The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

Conditions of applying for higher studies programs for the first semester of The Academic Year (2022/2023)

- The applicant must have a Bachelor's degree or any equivalent degree in order to apply for the Master degree program obtained from an accredited University, the student's bachelor and Master degrees should have been accomplished based on regular attendance.
- The bachelor's degree should be in a major that qualifies the applicants for the special study in the program he/she wants to join according to the study plan for that program. In some exceptional cases studied by the committee of the higher studies at the department and the faculty, the applicant who has a bachelor's degree in other specializations, may be accepted in the program.

- The applicant must apply or pass one of the foreign languages Tests (TOEFL, ILITS, French language, German language or English language (or an equivalent exam for English language) before 1-9-2022.
- The applicant must have certified approval from any employing institution such as the military armed forces, general security, and civil defence. For the non-Jordanian students; they must provide the document of their agencies if it requires a previous approval. Applicants who work at the Hashemite University are asked to provide the university's agreement as well.

General Requirements to Apply for Diploma Programs

- The student must have a bachelor's degree from a university approved by the Hashemite University.
- Students who have a non-regular bachelor's degree might be accepted in Diploma programs

Higher studies program for the first academic semester (2022-2023)

A- Master programs (33 accredited hours)

Faculty of Arts: thesis

1- Master of Peace and Conflict studies:

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in political sciences or any equivalent degree, such as international relations and strategic studies, law, or any specialization of the humanities and social studies, or water and environment management.

Faculty of Engineering: thesis

1- Master of Mechanical Engineering/ Energy Systems

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering.

2- Master of Constructions Engineering

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering.

Master of Architectural Engineering

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in any specialization of Architectural Engineering.

3- Master of Maintenance Management

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in any branch of Engineering specialization are accepted in this program.

Faculty of Prince El Hassan Bin Talal of natural resources and Environment (thesis)

1- Master of Climate Change and Arid Land Sustainability

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in farming, land and environment sciences, water and environment management, civil engineering or any of its equivalent.

2- Master of Applied Geology

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in Geology, environment or any equivalent or Mining Engineering or any equivalent.

Faculty of Nursing (thesis/ comprehensive exam)

1- Master of Nursing: including the following tracks : (Cancer Nursing/ Mental and Psychological health nursing/ Nursing of woman and mother health)

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in general nursing, nursing, nursing of midwifery and reproductive health.

Faculty of applied sciences (thesis):

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in clinical nutrition and diets, food

science, nutrition, food technology or any other scientific specialization.

To be accepted in the program, students must have a bachelor's degree in any academic specialization.
