The Architecture department participation in the shortlisted Newton Khaldi project 2021 Learning from Multicultural Amman is presented in a conference that celebrates the Museum international day and the centennial of the Hashemite Kingdom, sponsored by the president of the Jordan University. In this conference Dr Shatha Abu Khafajah presents the work of the Hashemite university students as part of their partnership in the project, while fulfilling the requirements of the Architectural heritage conservation module. The presentation weighs the experience of the students and its role in introducing them to public and private sectors in Jordan and the UK that intersect with their discipline. It also demonstrates how the students turned the material prepared in fulfilment of the SPC into a tool to communicate heritage with school children, therefore, the project, and the Hashemite students' role in it, provided a bridge between the higher education in Jordan and that of basic education.

It strengthened the students' sense of belonging to a wider community in which they can be active participants. It also provided students with prospects regarding their future career that go beyond conventional jobs into creative approaches in using architecture to communicate.
