#### STUDENTS' COMPETITIONS -Architect Safa Joudeh


USAID SCHEP presented recent graduate from the Hashemite University; architect Safa Joudeh with a travel scholarship to present her work at a conference on









# STUDENTS' COMPETITIONS - Architect Yasamin Al-Shurbajie
